1. Go to a site that has a free web page editor Like <http://free-auction-templates.com>
2. Fill in the blanks
3. At this point if you want graphics, logos do a google search for free graphics from companies like <http://www.grsites.com> and get your graphics, you will right click on image, and "save picture" or you will use pictures from your digital camera you have stored in your computer.
4. Now you will have to have these graphics hosted, go to <http://imageshack.us/> and they will host your images for free.
5. Browse for your image you have saved.
6. Click "host it"
7. Copy and paste what's on the "direct link to image" on the blank that say's "photo 1 url" on the free-auction-template site.
8. On the free-auction-site click "view ad" right beneath it you will see the html you have generated, copy and paste this on your description page for your auction.
